Ingredients of the ITES

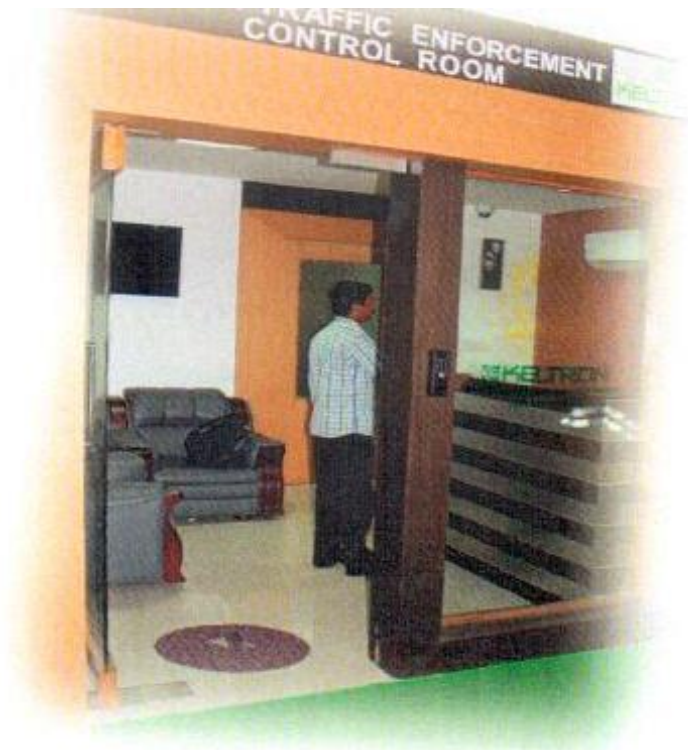
- 600 Speed-limit Violation Detection Systems (SVDS),
- 400 AI Camera (Artificial intelligent) based Enforcement System,
- 120 Mobile SVDS systems with vehicles,
- 120 Red-light Violation Detection Systems (RLVD)
- 400 Helmet Absence Detection Systems (HADS)
- identify non-compliance of the Expired Pollution Under Control (PUC) Certificate.

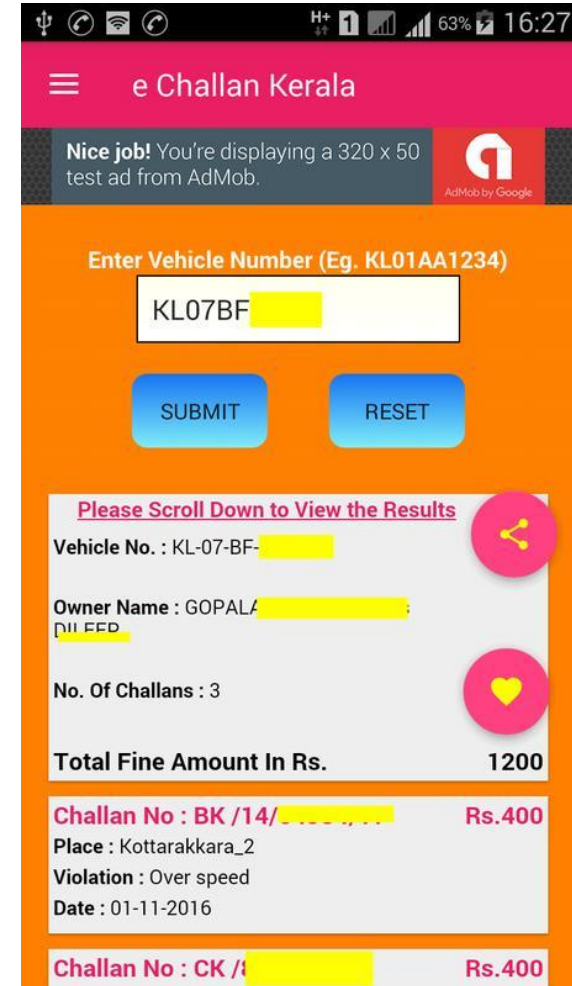
- Concession period of 10 years

Digital Enforcement and Fine collection in PPP Mode



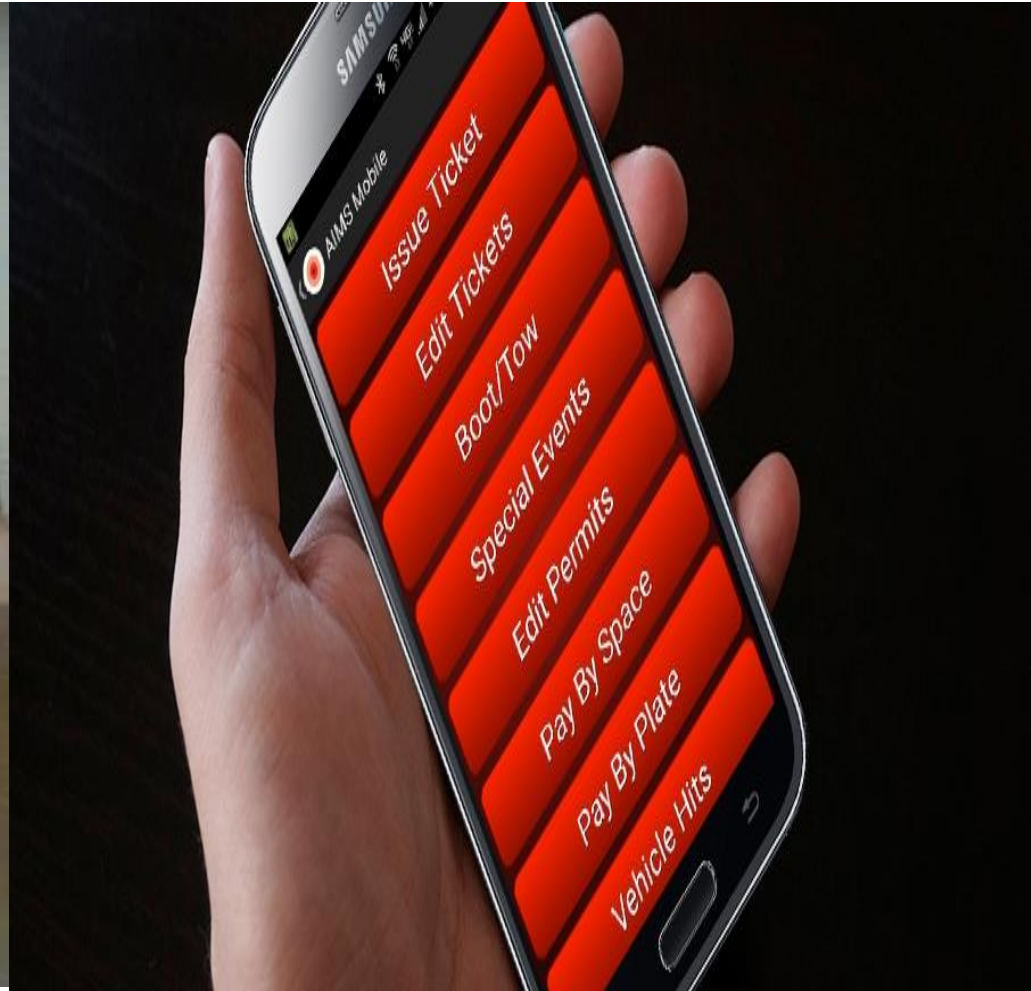
Mobile Application for enforcement

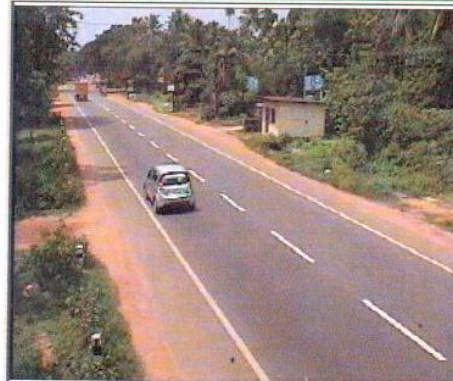
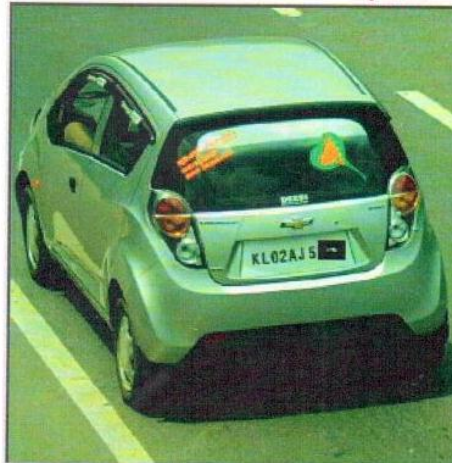


16 Digit Integrated Challan from Kerala Police

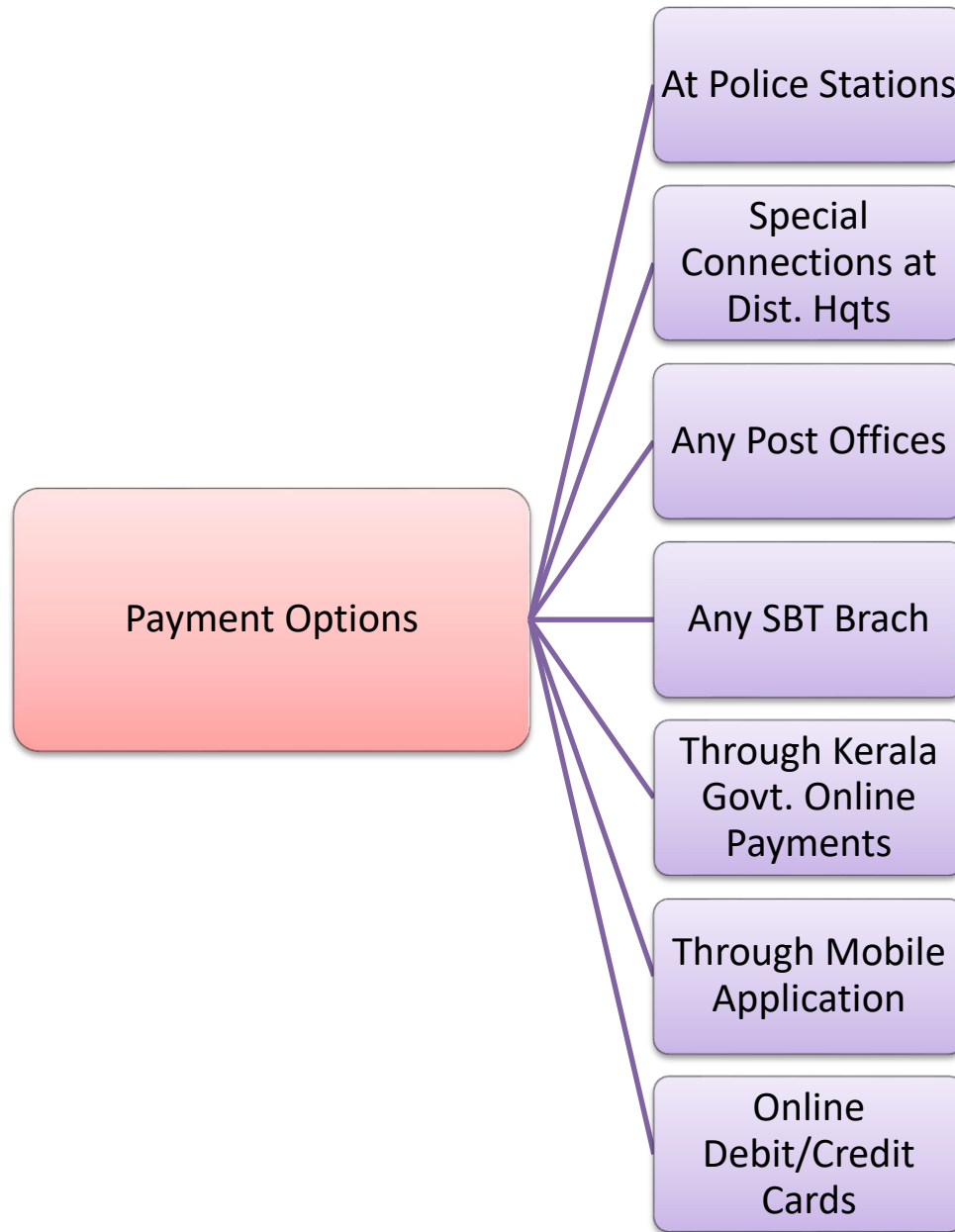
